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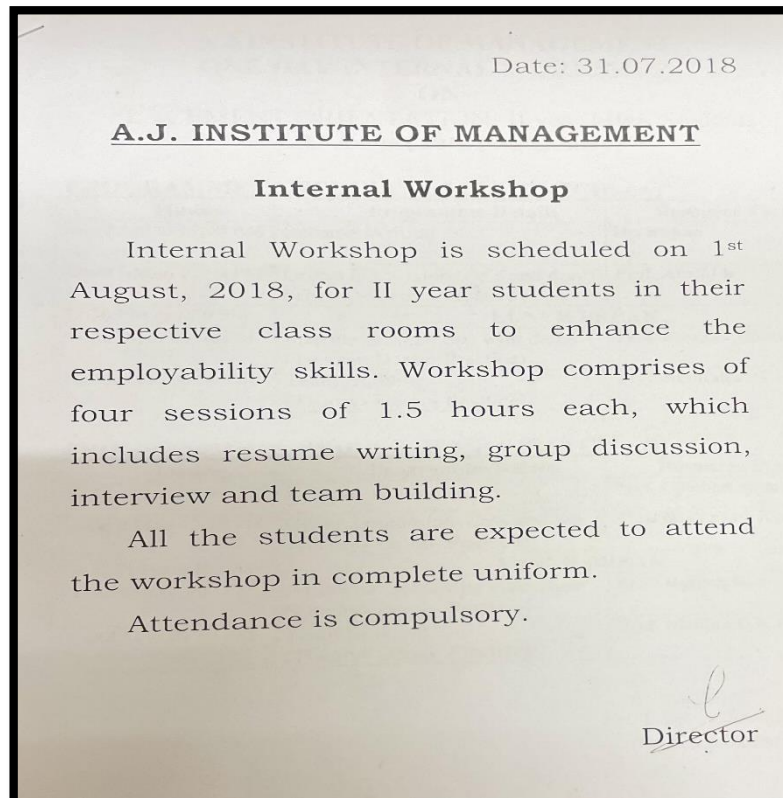
1. PLACEMENT ORIENTATION INTERNAL WORKSHOP

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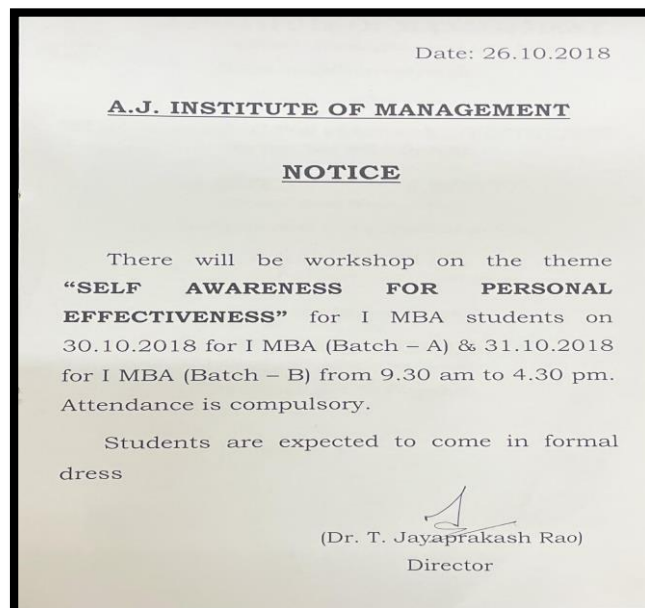
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1. SELF-AWARENESS FOR PERSONAL EFFECTIVENESS WORKSHOP
